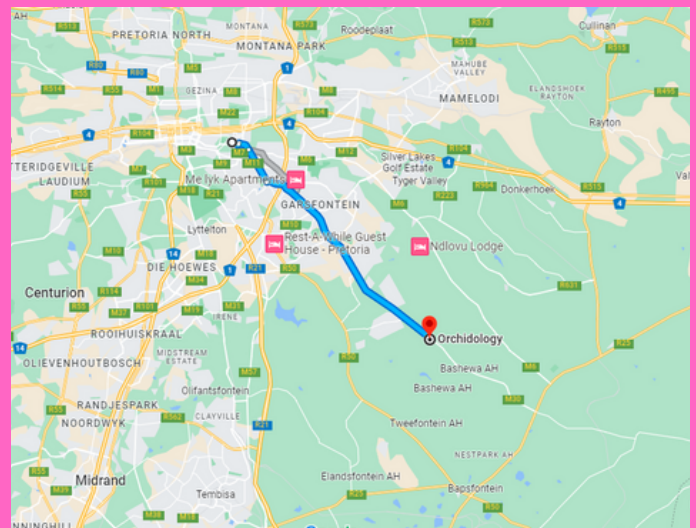


Dates

Natural pendulous

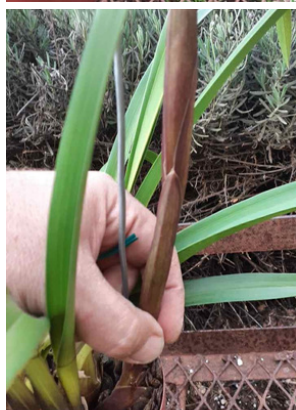


We stake our orchids to ensure that the blooms can be seen above the foliage, to ensure easier transport and to support the flowers to prevent them snapping off.

How to stake a cymbidium

The best time to attempt staking is later in the afternoon as the stems are softer and more pliable. You can use wooden or galvanised/plastic coated wire. Insert your stake deep into the pot so that it stands firmly, at least 2cm away from the edge of the orchid and 2cm from the edge of the pot.

Bend the spike towards the stake, not more than 15-30 degrees, do not force it. Some times they will only give 15 degrees or less, that's ok, then you have repeat the process every few days.



Once positioned you can tie the spike to the stake gently. We use green ties, some growers make use of clips. As the flower develops you may have to add additional ties or reposition the ties. The tie shouldn't be too tight, there should be enough freedom so that stem can still move and develop.

If using wire bend the top edge around to prevent it poking an eye.
