Catatante flowers with a 1 m+ spike with good branching habit, bright orange and is a great parent , easy to grow. Progeny have flowered yellow to white with brown to purple spotting

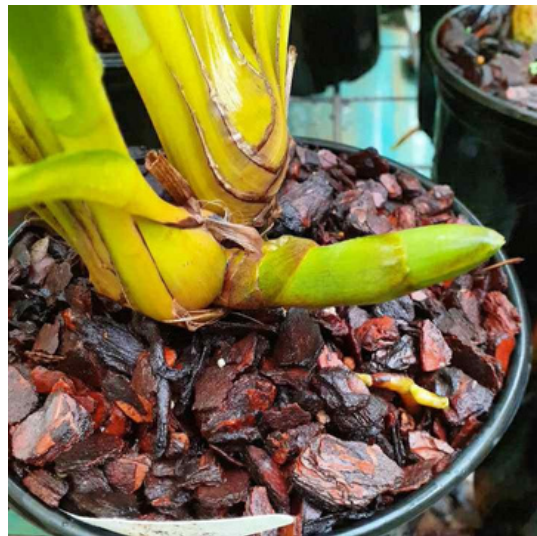
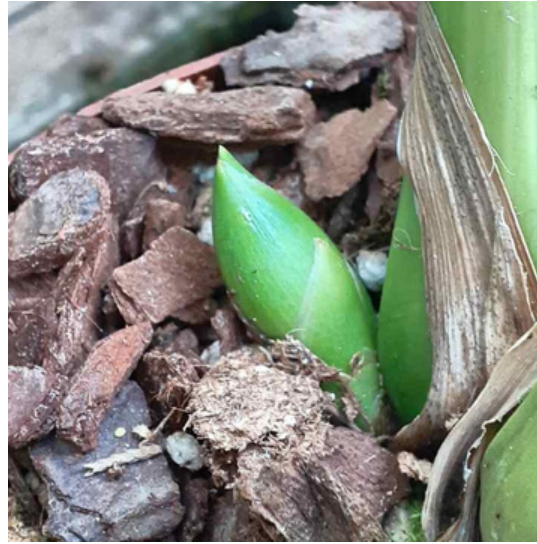

Orchidology



Cymbidiums generally flower from April to October, now is the time you can start looking for the buds of the early flowering ones. These present themselves at the base of the lead growths , which started growing early in spring and if they have matured and have had the correct cultural conditions. From a little bud they usually take 2-3 months before a flower has opened, During this time make sure to guard them from snails and slugs which can damage them. Temperatures should be kept constant and on the cool side otherwise the buds can 'Blast' - Going yellow and falling from their stem.
