Summer Flowering Cymbidiums

Summer flowering cymbidiums have different genentic makeup compared to those we are used too, these have their ancestry from cymbidium species from the subtroptical regions of South East Asia. The species used in the hybridisation are Cym. ensifolium, Cym. madidum and Cym. canaliculatum. Some summer flowering cymbidium species below



Cym. ensifolium

This small cymbidium species comes from China, Japan, India, Phillepines, Thailand and many other SE Asian countires. They come in different colours and are small in size. These cymbidiums are one of the lonest cultivated ornamental plants being grown in China and Japan for over 2000 years. They are sort after for their fragrance, colour varieties and variegated foliage. Since they flower in the summer months of February and March they are often used in hybridisation to creat early flowering varieties.

Cym. suavissimum

This rare cymbidium comes from Burma, not used much in hybridising but is an elgant plant with stems of 50 little highly fragrant blooms. It flowers January tand february.



Summer Flowering Cymbidiums

Cym. madidum

This cymbidium is found in North Eastern Australia. It is a large plant with big bulbs Cym.madidum has been used a lot in hybridisation of pendulous type cymbidiums, the off spring are robust plants with long inflorescense of 70 blooms.



Summer flowering orchids not only flower during the warmer months but also have other unique characteristics, many are fragrant especially Cym. ensifolium and its offsrping. They are also warmth tolerant, by which we mean that they are warmer growing and will tolerate heat of the subtropical areas in South Africa such as Durban and the KZN north coast, Mpumalanga lowveld and limpopo and flower well in these areas. The flowers are smaller than the cooler growing cymbidium types but often numerous.





Cym. canaliculatum

This cymbidium is found in North Eastern Australia. The plant has thick hard leathery leaves, which help they orchid cope with hard environmental conditions, it can with stand drought conditions in arid areas of Australia. The flowers vary in colour from beige, yellow, brown spotted to a dark almost black variety.

Summer Flowering Cymbidiums available at Orchidology

We have a Summer flowering cymbidium Bundle of 10 cymbidiums available, these are established seedlings and should flower within 2 years. They are hybrids of the Cym. ensifolium, madidum and canaliculatum species.
